In these 10 years our activities have covered 24 regions of Ukraine, and we are proud that we were able to support thousands of people in different parts of the country. During this time we:

- provided assistance to 135 hospitals worth more than 410 million hryvnias;
- purchased more than 986 units of medical equipment;
- helped over 147,000 people with humanitarian aid during the full-scale invasion;
- provided shelter for more than 5,5 thousand people in Lviv;
- support more than 77 orphanages and boarding schools;
- more than 500 people received help at our Family Center for Mental Health "Your Support"».





# THE FOUNDATION'S MISSION

EVERY PERSON IN UKRAINE WHO NEEDS HELP SHOULD RECEIVE IT IN A TIMELY AND HIGH-QUALITY MANNER.

We restore, strengthen and build systems, that guarantee social and humanitarian support to those in need.



#### **HUMANITY (HUMAN-CENTRISM)**

We create an environment in which all children, especially those war-affected, receive help while preserving their right to respect and dignity. A human is always at the center of all the decisions and projects that we implement.

#### **TRANSPARENCY**

It is important for us to be transparent and accountable. Therefore, we only act according to Ukrainian legislation. Every year we undergo audit at own expense.

#### **EFFICIENCY**

The main task of our charity foundation is to provide assistance in a timely and high-quality manner. We do not implement initiatives that are unnecessary. Therefore, any project of our foundation starts with an assessment of needs and requests. That's why we only work on projects where we have experience and expertise.

#### **DEVELOPMENT**

We are always looking for system solutions that will be long-term and sustainable. Even when we distribute food aid, we shape it so that it enables our beneficiaries to live in dignity and get a boost to development. We share our experience and practices with other players in the public sector. The Foundation also responsibly forms project packages, budgets, and schedules so that employees can learn, grow, and develop.

#### THE FIELDS OF THE FOUNDATION'S ACTIVITIES:



**Health care.** The Foundation has signed a Memorandum with the Ministry of Health. For 10 years, we have been supporting patients of Ukrainian hospitals by providing medical facilities with expert-class medical equipment, medicines, and consumables. The foundation also supports the main medical facilities where children with congenital heart defects are rescued and provides targeted assistance to such children. There are 135 hospitals under the care of the Foundation. We created and implemented a unique monitoring system that counts not only the amount of medical equipment provided to hospitals but also the number of patients and the services they received with this equipment. The responsible employees of the foundation have undergone the necessary training in monitoring and evaluation. Currently, such a monitoring system is implemented only in our fund.



**Assistance to children in residential institutions.** The Foundation supports children in orphanages and boarding facilities, providing them with everything they need: furniture, hygiene products, household chemicals, bed linen, etc.



**Family Center for Mental Health.** This is a space for those who need psychosocial support and professional advice. This is a safe place with a 470 square meters area, with a unique sensory space divided into 7 zones and an educational center to help children and families of the Bucha district. The complex of services is provided by a multidisciplinary team of specialists, namely: psychologists,, speech therapists, neuropsychologists, neuropedagogues, lawyers, leisure and extracurricular education specialists. The center also organizes lectures and trainings on sexual education, financial literacy, etc. The Center also organizes lectures and training on sexual education, financial literacy, etc.



**Humanitarian aid to victims of the war in Ukraine.** The fund provides humanitarian aid to children and adults who suffered from Russian aggression. We help in every region of Ukraine. We deliver products and medicines to de-occupied cities and towns where residents are left without basic necessities. More than 147,000 people have already received humanitarian aid from our fund.



**The shelter in Lviv.** The Fund, together with the companies "Ukrtelecom", "Shkola Pro PM", the general design and construction company "7CI GROUP" and other benefactors, united and created a shelter in Lviv to receive Ukrainians who have gone nowhere.

The shelter has received more than 5,000 people, and has been operating since March 2022. Now, this is a support shelter in Lviv, which provides residents with everything they need: accommodation, hot meals, necessary hygiene products, psychosocial support, organizes legal and medical assistance, helps with employment.



#### Educational support for charitable and public organizations.

The charitable foundation "Your Support" launched the project "Educational Support. Development course for charitable and public organizations".

This is a large-scale training course aimed at the development of such organizations. The course includes practical training and mentoring support. It covers such topics as attracting funding, working with businesses, fundraising, and learning how to avoid common mistakes in the early stages of activity.

This course was created with the support of ISAR Unity within the framework of the project "Initiative for Sectoral Support of Civil Society".

#### TRANSPARENCY AND RECOGNITION

Transparency is one of the key values of our foundation. We understand that the trust of our benefactors, partners, and the public is the core of our work. Therefore, we strive for maximum openness and accountability in all aspects of our work. We are one of the few charitable organizations in Ukraine that regularly engages independent auditors to check the intended use of funds to ensure that every hryvnia from our partners goes to charity. We actively cooperate with international organizations and foundations and exchange experience and knowledge to constantly improve our work. So we can ensure maximum efficiency of resource use. We are proud to have received certificates that confirm our compliance with the highest standards of charitable activity.

1. The foundation is certified by CAF International. The CAF International Validated Organization Badge is awarded to organizations that are structured and operated as nonprofit entities. This is confirmed by a validation process that goes far beyond a simple reliance on a foreign government database.





The CAF International validating process includes a review of an organization's key operational elements such as their governance structure, registration status, annual financial statements, online and media presence, and their board members and senior staff. This validating process ensures that all funds sent to the organization will be used charitably, and it allows the CAF International and their donors to mitigate the risk of fraud, money laundering, and other criminal activities.

2. "Your Support" is the only active local focal point of Minimum humanitarian standards of response SPHERE in Ukraine. Country focal points are organisations who actively promote and advocate for the application of the Sphere standards at country-level. «SPHERE» was founded in 1997 year by a group of professionals aiming to improve the quality of humanitarian work during disasters and crises. Today, SPHERE unites 14 focal points in Europe, including Ukraine (our foundation) and 71 worldwide.





#### TRANSPARENCY AND RECOGNITION

3. The Foundation is the only Ukrainian organization that is a member of the World Heart Federation (WHF). WHF is a non-governmental organisation (NGO) in official relations with the World Health Organization (WHO).

WHF plays a leading role in the fight against cardiovascular disease (CVD), bringing together scientists, patients, cardiologists, and other health workers from around the world. WHF supports government health programs and educates the public about CVD prevention. Based on the latest scientific achievements, WHF organizes various events and encourages people to share knowledge and experience to help them protect themselves from heart disease. The proactive stance of WHF regarding the prevention and control of CVD inspires like-minded people to follow this path.



**4.** The Foundation is a co-founder and member of the Alliance of Ukrainian Civil Society Organizations (Alliance UA CSO). In cooperation with other interested parties, the Alliance of Ukrainian Civil Society Organizations has been a leader in developing a Strategy for local leadership in humanitarian crisis response. **Alliance UA CSO** is also a leader in laying a foundation for the effective reconstruction of Ukraine.

The humanitarian response system in Ukraine can be a successful example of localization - an important learning moment for international and Ukrainian response actors.

The ultimate goal of localization is always a humanitarian response and recovery efforts. Such actions are fully led and performed by local participants supported by the international community. It provides a channel for valuing of solidarity globally.





# FAMILY CENTER FOR MENTAL HEALTH IN VORZEL

**Family Center for Mental Health** – is a space where comprehensive professional assistance is provided, based on a person-oriented approach and the development of comprehensive solutions for children and their families. Programs for adults and children include innovative methods and approaches to improve their psychological and physical health.

#### **RECIPIENTS OF THE CENTER'S SERVICES:**

- Children, adolescents, and adults affected by the negative impact of the war in Ukraine;
- Children and families of military personnel;
- Families with children who are in difficult life circumstances and in financial hardship;
- Children with special educational needs;
- · Internally displaced families;
- Families with alternative forms of care: adoption, guardianship/custodianship, foster families, family-based care, and family-type orphanages.

#### MULTISECTORAL SUPPORT BY A MULTIDISCIPLINARY TEAM:

- Child and adolescent psychologist;
- · Adult psychologist;
- Neuropsychologists;
- Neuropedagogues;
- · Speech therapists;
- Special education specialists;
- · Case managers;
- · Legal advisors.



#### PSYCHOLOGICAL SUPPORT FOR CHILDREN AND ADULTS:

- Emotional support and trauma work
- · Psychological support for loss and grief
- Crisis intervention and crisis psychological support
- Therapeutic groups
- Psychological support for families with children
- Art therapy and creative approaches
- Development of cognitive and learning skills
- Psychological education and prevention
- Burnout prevention and anxiety reduction, and more.

#### The psychosocial support program for the target audience includes:

• Sensory Room for Children and Adolescents (the largest in Kyiv region):

In the sensory room, children receive support aimed at improving their emotional, mental, and physical well-being. The sensory room utilizes special methods and equipment that help children relax, calm down, and develop certain skills.



- Addressing educational gaps and activities for children: learning through play and project-based learning, soft skills development intensives, and more.
- STEM activities (Maker Space): robotics, programming, and more.
- Educational and awareness activities for parents: positive parenting, financial literacy and selfemployment, domestic violence prevention, safety, and more.
- Psychosocial support for veterans' families, families of active-duty military, families of the fallen or
  missing soldiers: psychological support and counseling, individual and group therapy sessions, and
  more.













Promotion of Social Integration for IDPs: Community-Level Activities to Improve Social Cohesion and Integration of IDP Families for Adults and Children:

- Cultural and recreational integration events
- Social activities for the elderly to enhance psychosocial well-being
- · Creative workshops, quests, physical activities, board games for children, film screenings, and more

Legal consultations on determining priority measures to improve the social protection of children in territorial communities.

The Charitable Foundation "Your Support" in partnership with Kateryna Osadcha's Foundation as part of the "Hugs for a Child" project, and Kyiv Regional Center of Social Services conducts center-based trainings for groups of potential adoptive parents (various forms of family arrangements).

#### Sports classes for adults and adults with children:

- TRE (Trauma releasing exercises) for adults;
- pilates + fitness for adults;
- "Mother+" classes for parents with children aged 2 to 5 years.

There are also mass entertainment events and holidays for children, such as: Children's Day, Ice Cream Day, Holiday for children with MILUPA, Charity Family Day on the territory of the partners' and Center's territory.

### **HUMANITARIAN AID TO VICTIMS OF THE WAR**

#### This is our response to the challenges of the times



Since the beginning of the full-scale Russian invasion of Ukraine, our Foundation has been actively involved in providing assistance to war victims from the very first days. We understood that in this difficult time, our support is vital for the thousands of people who were in a difficulty during the occupation.

Today, we continue to actively support people from the regions near the combat zone, where humanitarian aid is urgently needed. Among them there are many families with children, including children with disabilities, who need special attention and support.

This large-scale humanitarian aid project is aimed at supporting the affected population and internally displaced persons. After all, thousands of people lost their homes, jobs, and means of livelihood during the war, and our help was vital for them.

Our project is designed to provide war victims and IDPs with essential goods: food, hygiene products, clothes, shoes, bed linen, and other necessities.

On March 6, 2022, to help Ukrainians, the Charitable Foundation "Your Support", together with the companies "Ukrtelecom," Pro PM School, 7CI GROUP design and construction company, Volodymyr Borodyansky, Ilona Schneider, and Natalia Deren, joined forces to run the "Your Support" Shelter in Lviv.

This is a vivid example of how the pooling of resources and experts can lead to the creation of important social initiatives. The "Your Support" shelter has become the greatest place of care, an island of safety and support for those who lost their home and their usual way of life due to the war. This project became a reality thanks to the efforts of the Foundation, which took over search for funding and implementation.




## REANIMOBILES FOR DNIPRO, KHARKIV, AND BILA TSERKVA 2023-2024 YEARS

The "Your Support" Foundation implemented an important project aimed at saving the lives of newborns as part of its mission to help those who need it most. With the support of **Crédit Agricole Ukraine** and **the French Crédit Agricole Group**, two reanimoblies-transformers equipped with up-to-date medical equipment were purchased.**PepsiCo Company** helped us purchase another ambulance **for the Bila Tserkva hospital in the Kyiv region**.

#### Reanimobile for Dnipro

The first reanimobile was transferred to a children's medical institution in the city of Dnipro. During this year, a reanimobile of the neonatal intensive care unit leaves almost every day to save someone's little life (261 trips were made). It became especially important for the transportation of children from the frontline territories, such as Nikopol. Due to the quick work of doctors and the modern equipment of the ambulance, it is possible to quickly and safely deliver children to medical institutions, where they are provided with the necessary assistance.



#### Reanimobile for Kharkiv

The second reanimobile was transferred to the Kharkiv medical facility in December 2023. During this time, he helped 79 babies. One of the vivid examples of his work is the rescue of a premature child who was born in a critical condition in the Balakliiv Central Regional Clinical Hospital. Thanks to the quick response of the resuscitation team and the presence of modern equipment in the ambulance, the child was saved and taken to a specialized medical facility.



#### Reanimobile for Bila Tserkva

In June 2024, we also provided the medical institution of the city of Bila Tserkva with a reanimobile.

Reanimobile, equipped with modern medical equipment, has become a reliable assistant for doctors in transporting newborns and premature babies.

During the year, such a car can provide safe transportation of more than 120 babies, giving them a chance at life.

# CONSTRUCTION OF THE INTENSIVE CARE UNIT IN KYIV REGIONAL PERINATAL CENTER 2023-2024 years.

The repair of the Kyiv Regional Perinatal Center is one of the Fund's strategic projects. Financial support from our partner, **Crédit Agricole**, made it possible. The opening of a new intensive care unit—a neonatal intensive care unit—will allow doctors to save even more small lives. Crédit Agricole Brie Picardie and Crédit Agricole Ukraine allocated 2.3 million hryvnias for major repairs of the facilities, thus increasing the number of beds to 12.

The unit is constructed in compliance with all the medical standards and requirements.

## PROJECT "PROVISION OF GENERATORS AS A SUPPORT FOR SOCIAL INSTITUTIONS": A LIGHT OF HOPE IN THE DARKNESS OF WAR

Russian attacks on Ukraine's energy infrastructure leave thousands of people without electricity and heat, especially vulnerable categories of the population children, the elderly, and people with disabilities. In such conditions, ensuring the smooth operation of social institutions becomes critically important. The Foundation "Your Support" together with Credit Agricole Ukraine and CREDIT AGRICOLE BRIE PICARDIE launched a project to support social institutions in to provide them with reliable sources of electricity. Thanks to the project, 42 powerful generators were purchased and transferred to 27 social institutions throughout Ukraine, including:

- orphanages
- rehabilitation centers for children
- - psychoneurological boarding schools

- geriatric boarding houses
- medical institution





There are often cases when Ukrainins find themselves trapped under the rubber and on fire during rocket attacks. Every minute matters when it comes to saving a life. Understanding this, the charitable foundation "Your Support" together with the donor Prosus Services B.M. launched the project "Support of the State Emergency Service of Kyiv". Kyiv rescuers received powerful and modern equipment that has already proven its effectiveness in real conditions.

#### **HYDRAULIC LIFT MAN B55**

It can reach a 20-story building in three minutes, lift 6-7 people at the same time, as well as a person in a wheelchair. This 55-meter lift has become an indispensable assistant during the evacuation of people and fire fighting. During operation since February 2023, it traveled **1208 km** Ta worked for **3940 hours**. During this period, the lift was used **45 times** on fires, **5** of which were during rocket attacks.





#### MAN TGS 28.500 ACC TRACTOR AND LOW-FRAME TRAILER

This powerful transport complex ensures prompt delivery of heavy equipment to the scene. It was repeatedly used to eliminate the consequences of hostile attacks on objects of the critical infrastructure of Kyiv. This complex is also used for:

- transportation of the Magirus Wolf C1 tactical response robot (fire robot) and other specialized equipment to different regions of Ukraine;
- delivery of a backhoe loader for the construction of fortifications in the Donetsk region;
- provision of backup power generators for Kharkiv, Donetsk, Zaporizhzhia, and Odesa regions;
- delivery of specialized equipment for demining the territories of the Kharkiv region.

During operation, the tractor and trailer traveled **14 592 kilometers,** carrying important tasks across Ukraine.

# ASSISTANCE TO MEDICAL INSTITUTIONS WITH THE SUPPORT OF PROSUS SERVICES B.V

The project provided **15 hospitals** with necessary medical equipment worth **129,627,495.78 UAH** in various regions of Ukraine The project provided 15 hospitals with necessary medical equipment in the amount of UAH 129,627,495.78 in various regions of Ukraine. This equipment includes operating tables, cardiac systems, ventilators, anesthesia systems, ultrasound systems, intensive care beds and much more. We have agreed on the list of equipment with with the Ministry of Health and focused on the medical facilities that needed the most help. The purpose of the project is to provide life-saving equipment, such as resuscitation, cardiac and lung ventilation machines, which was necessary since the beginning of the war. Thanks to the project, more than 12 million patients will receive high-quality medical care throughout Ukraine.

# THE PROJECT «HOME FOR CHILDREN» 2022-2024 years

This project, founded in 2022 together with Kateryna Osadcha, aims to buy housing for family-type orphanages that lost their homes due to the war.

We pay special attention to family-type orphanages (FTO) . These are families that have adopted at least five children left without parental care.

Unfortunately, the war deprived more than 300 such families of their homes. The "Home for Children" project has already helped to buy housing for three FTO families, but there is still a lot of work ahea.









Thanks to the support of caring people, a significant amount was collected, which made it possible to implement the first steps of the project. However, in order to help all families in need, further support is needed.

A family from the Donetsk region - 11 family members
A family from the Kherson region - 11 family members
A family from the Luhansk region - 9 family members
Belytskyi family from Donetsk region - 13 family members

The project is being implemented in cooperation with Daria Herasymchuk, the authorized adviser to the President of Ukraine, on children's rights and child rehabilitation, which guarantees compliance with all the rights and interests of children.








## CHARITY WEEKEND EVENTS 2014-2019 YEARS

The explosion of the Kakhovskaya hydroelectric power plant (HPP) led to an environmental disaster, leaving millions of Ukrainians without access to clean drinking water. The largest water reservoir, which once provided drinking water to Ukrainians, has been destroyed. Restoring not only buildings but also ecosystems can take years...

The musical group Kalush Orchestra joined forces with the "Your Support" foundation to solve the problem of water supply once they received an official letter from the head doctor of Kherson's medical institution.



Thanks to joint efforts, 1,824,833 UAH were collected, which made it possible to purchase and install two water purification systems in the Kherson region hospital. Now the medical facility and its patients have access to clean drinking water, which is extremely important for their health and recovery.

## KEEP "ART DEFENSE" IN COLLABORATION WITH MONATIK 2023-2024 YEARS

"ART Defense" in collaboration with MONATIK – art stands on the protection of Ukraine.

In response to the tragedy at the Kakhovskaya HPP and with the aim of supporting war victims, the "Your Support" foundation, together with MONATIK, launched the "ART Defense" charity tour.

During concerts, MONATIK collects funds for the humanitarian needs of affected Ukrainians. Charity auctions and activities are held at each concert, with the participation of Nashe Radio, MUZVAR, and the M1 music TV channel.

#### **Support of Kherson Oblast:**

After the first five concerts of the tour, **280,911.34 UAH were collected,** which were directed to help 300 families of the Khersonska oblast, affected by the explosion of the Kakhovskaya HPP. People received water purification tablets, blankets, power banks, animal feed, buckets, and life jackets.

#### Help for the Shelter "Your Support":

During the concert in Lviv, MONATIK visited the Shelter "Your Support" and donated funds for new household appliances. A painting by an artist from Izyum, who lost her home due to the war, was sold during a charity auction. All collected funds were directed to the needs of war victims.

#### Music art therapy:

The "ART Defense" tour takes place with the support of the Center for Moral and Psychological Support of the Armed Forces, as one of its tasks is musical art therapy for military and civilians.

## THE GUIDANCE FOR THE NEXT 10 YEARS

Ten years ago, we started our mission to help those who need it most. During this time, we have done a lot: saved lives, gave hope, supported, and united. But there is still so much ahead!

#### The next decade is a time of new challenges and new victories:

- **1. Health care.** We will continue to support Ukrainian hospitals by expanding our programs for the supply of medical equipment, medicines, and consumables. In the next 10 years, we plan to:
  - expand the network of hospitals that constantly receive our help to 300 medical institutions;
  - improve our unique monitoring system to more effectively evaluate the results of our assistance and implement it in other charities;
  - increase targeted assistance to children with congenital heart defects, providing them with high-quality medical care and support.
- **2.** Assistance to orphans and children deprived of parental care. We strive to provide comfortable conditions for life and for children's development. Our plans for the future are:
  - an increase in funding for providing housing for children who lost their homes during the war (a family-type children's home).
  - creation of socialization and support programs for teenagers preparing for independent life.
- **3. Development of the Family Center for Mental Health.** We want to expand the activities of our Center to provide even more people with psychosocial support. We plan to:
  - · open extra centers of mental health in other regions of Ukraine;
  - expand the range of services, including new trainings and seminars on important social topics;
  - attract more specialists to our multidisciplinary team to provide quality services...
- **4. Humanitarian aid and support for IDPs.** We will continue to provide humanitarian assistance to all victims of war, expanding our efforts. We will attract new partners and donors для to increase humanitarian aid.
- **5. The Shelter in Lviv.** Our shelter "Your Support" shelter will remain an important center of support for displaced people. We are currently planning to increase the number of places to stay, expand employment and social integration programs for shelter residents, and support initiatives for psychosocial care, medical care, and legal support for all residents.

We believe that the next decade will be a time of new achievements and victories for the "Your Support" Foundation. Together with you, our donors and partners, we will continue our mission - to help those who need it most, do even more good, and build a better future for Ukraine.

Your support is not just financial help, it is faith in our common future.


